Summer session FAQ's

1. What class level should I enroll my child in?
 - We place students into classes based on their age. If your child has taken the same type of dance class in the previous year they can enroll into the advance level of the same class with in your child's age range.
 - Example 1: Age 5 wants to take ballet; no previous experience. Place him/her into the Beginners Ballet age 5-6
 - Example 2: Age 8 wants to take tumbling; he/she took Tumbling Basics last year . Place him/her into Intermediate Tumbling age 8-10
2. What does the different levels (B), (I), and (A)mean?
 - (B): Basics- Never taken class before or has very little experience.
 - (I): Intermediate-Taken a basics class or meets the minimum required age AND skill level for the class
 - (A): Advanced- Must have taken Intermediate level or have teacher approval before moving up to Advanced Level
3. Do we need to purchase dancewear from Norwalk Dance Center?
 - The only items that must be purchased from NDC are the specific T-shirts (cheer & hip hop), white acrobatic shoes
4. How do I register my child for classes?
 - You will need to fill out a registration form, sign & date the front and back. You can also register on-line at www.norwalkdancecenter.com

Dress Code:

- **Ballet** - Black leotard, pink tights, pink leather ballet shoes
- **Jazz** - Black leotard, (can wear jazz shorts/jazz pants over leotard) tan tights & black jazz shoes
- **Tap** – Black leotard, tan tights, & black tap shoes
- **Hip Hop** – Black NDC Hip Hop T-shirt(must be purchased through NDC), black pants or shorts & clean tennis shoes
- **Tumble** – Black leotard & white acro shoes, we also suggest black shorts- Special Note: No t-shirts are permitted in tumbling classes for safety reasons. You child may warm-up with them on but must take them off at request of the instructor
- **Cheer** – Black NDC Cheer T-shirt(must be purchased through NDC), black shorts, and white acro shoes
